Its Old Course, voted number four course in Ireland, was designed by Old Tom Morris and later enhanced by Dr Alistair MacKenzie in 1926. The Club is also home to 'The South', Ireland's oldest Amateur Championship, which has been won by Major Champions Graeme McDowell, Darren Clarke and 2019 Dubai Duty Free Irish Open host Paul McGinley.
